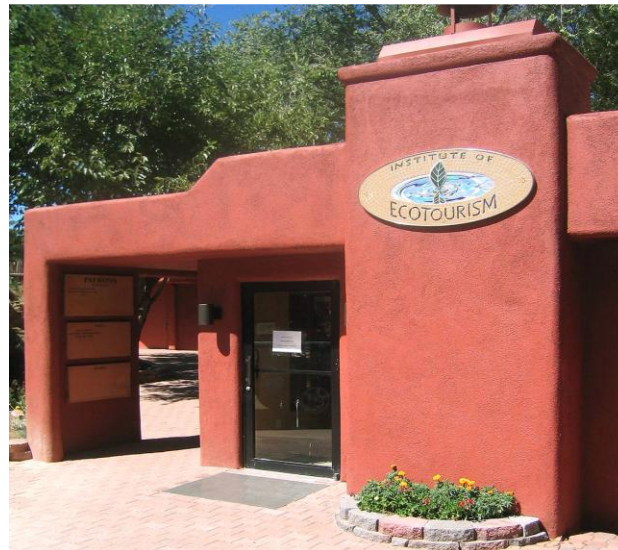

EcoTraveler Tips:

- Take only pictures, leave only footprints.
- Spend your money locally.
- Conserve resources, fewer showers, reuse towels/linens.
- Walk whenever possible.
- Stay on the trails.
- Gain cultural knowledge.
- Use the least polluting transportation.
- Eat local produce.

EcoHome Tips:

- Turn off the water while brushing your teeth.
- Use compact fluorescent light bulbs.
- Buy recycled or recyclable items.
- Plant a vegetable garden.
- Mulch around trees and plants to retain water.
- Carpool with neighbors to shop or work.
- Minimize garbage disposal use; start composting.
- Turn off or down thermostats

EcoWork Tips:

- fax on paper already used on one side.
- Buy in bulk. Team buy with another office.
- Send documents electronically.
- Use reusable cups and plates for meetings.
- Organize a "Green Team".
- Turn off computer when not in use.
- Use "eco- friendly" cleaning products.
- Laptops consume 90% less energy than desktops.
